Exciting Summer Activities at the Barn

Summer is the busiest season at the barn! In May, we welcomed a special group of visitors: Hero's Bridge. They were treated to a tour and demonstration of our Liberty Team and Mounted Archery Team's accomplishments. It was an honor to spend time with these heroes and show our appreciation for their service.

In addition, we received a thoughtful hay donation from Eric Gerber of Gainesville, Virginia. Thanks to his generosity, we received over 650 square bales of hay.

This required lots of volunteers, two trucks, two trailers, and two trips to transport. We filled our hay barn and stored the rest in the arena. We are grateful for Mr. Gerber's kindness and the volunteers who

helped!

But wait, there's more! In June, we held Summer Youth
Clinics for two weeks. One week was open to the
community, and the other was reserved for CCLC
students. During clinic week, we participated in the
Amissville Fireman's Parade and won Best Equine Entry
for the second year in a row! We also welcomed three
beautiful OTTBs that were part of a seizure of over 100
mistreated and malnourished horses from a farm in the
Shenandoah County area. This marked Serendipity's first
partnership with equine rescues Hope's Legacy and
Central Virginia Horse Rescue, and we hope to continue
working together in the future. The girls have recovered

Summer 2023 Youth Internship Program

Five of our volunteer staff members have taken the initiative to learn and appreciate equine education and management through our internship program. The interns have been responsible for conducting health and wellness checks, administering topical preventatives, and providing injury care to the horses. Each intern was assigned a Capstone project, which included field enrichment activities, plant and garden enrichment containing herbs and grasses, sensory trail enhancement, and pond clean-up efforts. Their performance was so impressive that Serendipity has decided to extend the internship program into the school year, providing the interns with more time to research and document their findings.
